In order to receive scholarships and cash prizes, contestants must attend at least 5 parades.**

Areas of Competition

Personal Interviews

All contestants will experience a personal interview with the judges in a panel style interview. Judges will be provided with a copy of the contestant's bio sheet. During the interview, the judges will ask the contestant questions based on their contestant bio sheet. Each contestant will have 3 minutes with the judges. Interviews will be held on Saturday, August 26, 2018 at Texas Trust Bank beginning at 2:00 P.M.

Western Wear

Each contestant must wear a Western outfit that displays their personality and style. Outfits must be appropriate, no midriffs or bare skin. No props are allowed. While dressed in western wear, all contestants will participate in a short group routine. The routine will be taught to the contestants on Sunday, August 19, 2018.

On Stage Introductions

Each contestants will receive 30 seconds to give a short introduction of themselves. (Please, do not exceed 30 seconds.)

Example: My name is John Doe and I am the 7 year old son of John & Jane Doe. I attend Yorktown Elementary and I am in 2nd grade. I like to play football with my friends. When I grow up I want to be a fireman.

Junior Miss & Miss contestants should also include the answer to the following question in their introduction:
“Why should you become the next Junior Miss Yorktown or Miss Yorktown?”

On Stage Question

Contestants in each division will be asked an age appropriate question on stage by the MC. Each contestant will receive different questions.

Formal Wear

Miss, Jr. Miss and Young Miss must wear an age appropriate floor length formal dress. Select a dress style and color that enhances your natural beauty. Bare skin and midriffs are not allowed. Young Mister Participants should wear slacks and a dress shirt. **Mini and Little Miss & Mister contestants will only participate in the western wear category**

Frequently Asked Questions

WHAT IS THE MISS YORKTOWN PAGEANT?

The Miss Yorktown Pageant is a scholarship program that encourages contestants to be their own individuals while supporting their community. Our goal is to provide the youth with opportunities to excel as young adults. We strive to provide an environment in which contestants have the opportunity to better themselves, gain self-awareness, self-confidence, individual pride, and greater social awareness. Each contestant will improve their ability to communicate effectively, speak in front of people, and stand up for their beliefs. This pageant is open to contestants living and attending school and reside in Yorktown or Nordheim.

WHAT TYPE OF PAGEANT IS THIS?

The Miss Yorktown Pageant is a scholarship program held to select representatives for the city of Yorktown. Contestants are judged on their personality, poise, presence, confidence, speaking ability and personal appearance. Clothing, hairstyle, and makeup should be age appropriate.

WHAT IS THE REGISTRATION FEE TO ENTER THE PAGEANT?

There is an early registration fee of \$25 that is due Friday, August 17, 2018. If you do not meet the early registration deadline then a \$30 registration fee is due no later than Tuesday, August 21, 2018. All registration forms and fee should be turned into the Yorktown Western Days Association office at 141 South Riedel Street.

WHAT DO I NEED TO ENTER THE 2018-2019 MISS YORKTOWN PAGEANT?

This entry packet includes all of the forms that must be completed to enter the pageant. The contestant must complete and turn in the entry forms and entry fee.

In addition, each contestant must create a resume style bibliography. Each bio must include a 5" x 7" or less photo of the contestant, explain why he/she believes they should be the winner in their category of the Miss Yorktown Pageant; list all the activities they have participated in and the achievements they have received.

A checklist is included to help you complete the full registration process. Contestants are encouraged to turn in their entry forms as soon as it is complete. All required items must be submitted by Tuesday, August 21, 2018. Failure to do so will result in disqualification from the pageant.

WHAT WILL I RECEIVE AS A PAGEANT CONTESTANT?

All contestants will be pictured in the program book and will receive a copy of the souvenir program book. Contestants will also receive a pageant t-shirt. Contestant photos and information will also be provided in a press release to the local newspaper.

ARE THERE REHERSALS OR MEETINGS THAT CONTESTANT'S & PARENT'S MUST ATTEND?

Yes, there is a Pageant Orientation meeting Thursday, August 16, 2018 at the Yorktown Chamber of Commerce. All parents/guardian and contestants should attend this meeting. Important information will be provided and questions will be answered. (Contestants unable to attend due to church obligations will be excused but a parent/guardian must attend.)

Rehearsal will be August 19, beginning at 1:00 PM.
